Wye Valley Council Consortium – Proposals for a wye valley river charter.

Cllr Snell raised the issue of an upcoming road closure that Gloucestershire County Council has arranged without notifying Monmouthshire CC, Llandogo School or the Community Council. The diversion is going to disrupt bus routes during examination periods.
